Half Moon Bay Charity Golf Classic

02, July 2003 – Daly City, CA: Seton Medical Center and Seton Medical Center Coastside will host their 22nd annual Half Moon Bay Charity Golf Classic on Thursday, July 24th, and Friday, July 25th, at the Half Moon Bay Golf Links.

The tournament will be held on the Old Course on Thursday, July 24th, with a Shotgun Start-Individual Stroke Format, and on the Ocean Course on Friday, July 25th, with a Shotgun Start-Scramble Format. Tee times on both days will be at 12:30 p.m. Lunch will be provided during registration which begins at 11 a.m.

The two-day tournament will feature exciting putting contests, outstanding tee prizes, and a silent and live auction. Auction items will include sporting event tickets, resort stays, fine dining, and original art. This year's raffle prize will feature a one-week stay for two at the award-winning luxurious hotel, the Fairmont Orchid, located on Hawaii's Big Island. Also included is two rounds of golf at the famous Francis I'i Brown Golf Course.

The cost is \$600 per golfer per day, or \$2,400 per foursome per day, which includes lunch, on-course refreshments, and dinner in the Ballroom at the Ritz-Carlton Half Moon Bay. The evening program will feature live music by the TJ Moore Blues Band, dancing, a no-host bar, local celebrities, and special guests.

The proceeds from the 2003 Seton Golf Classic will benefit emergency services at Seton Medical Center Coastside in Moss Beach. Seton Coastside's emergency room has state-of-the-art equipment, and is staffed twenty-four hours a day. It is the only emergency service facility on the Coast from Daly City to Santa Cruz. The Golf Classic will also benefit the Radiation Oncology Department at Seton Medical Center in Daly City. Seton Medical Center's Radiation Oncology Department treats over 300 cancer patients per year, many of whom are low-income.
